and in alignment with the CBE Education Plan,

acknowledges and supports the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of
Canada's (TRC) Calls to Action, and makes the following commitment to action
for the 2025-2026 school year:

We will build and apply knowledge of how to integrate Indigenous community values
such as **reciprocity and respect** and how these are lived in relationships with
Indigenous students, families, Elders, community members, and the land. This will
include learning from the land and creating opportunities to connect through story, art,
and shared experiences rooted in belonging.

We will engage our school community in learning about the land on which our school is
located, deepening our understanding of its history, meaning, and caretakers. Students,
staff, and families will be invited to **share their learning and take action** through our
use of the CBE and Personal Land Acknowledgement, building personal connections
and commitments to Truth and Reconciliation.

Our commitment was inspired by the Call to Action 63.3: Commit to learning about and
through Indigenous knowledges focused on building student capacity for intercultural
understanding, empathy, and mutual respect (focus on renewing respectful relationships
between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples).
